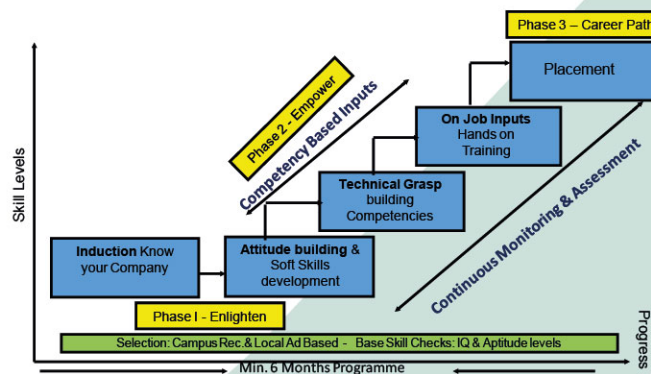
Supporting Localization Drive:

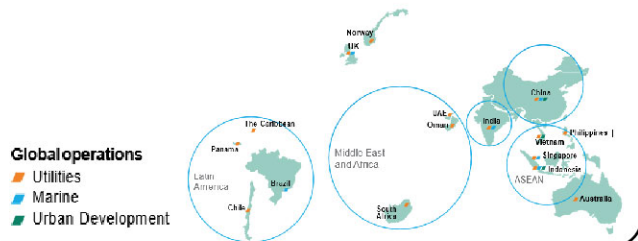

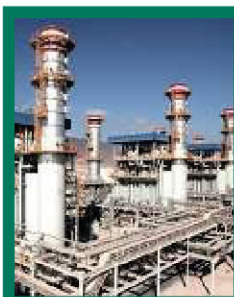
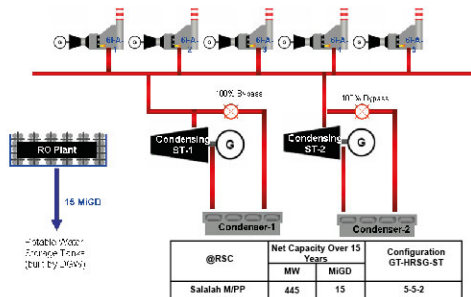

State of the Art Technology

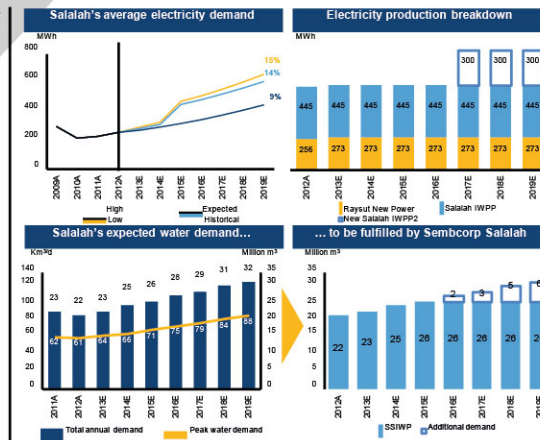
- The Sembcorp Salah Power facility integrates 5 units of Gas Turbines with 5 units of Heat Recovery Steam Generators and 2 Steam Turbines in a combined cycle configuration to achieve optimal energy production efficiency.
- The water facility combines 3 Seawater desalination treatment processes comprising of dual-media filtration, two-pass Reverse Osmosis and post-treatment re-mineralization to produce high quality potable water.
